QUESTIONS YOU MIGHT GET ASKED

WHY ARE YOU IN THE SAME CLOTHES FOR THREE DAYS?

So glad you asked! I'm taking part in The Sudsy Challenge to help support the 1 in 200 Australians who are experiencing homelessness.

WHAT'S THE SUDSY CHALLENGE?

The Sudsy Challenge is about wearing the same outfit for three days, starting conversations and raising funds and awareness for Orange Sky, so everyone can have access to a laundry van like Sudsy.

SO, WHO IS SUDSY?

Sudsy is the name of Orange Sky's first ever mobile laundry van built in 2014. Since then, the organisation has grown A LOT. They now have 31 services and support people doing it tough all over Australia.

WHY THREE DAYS?

It took Nic and Lucas, the co-founders of Orange Sky, three days (and three sets of washing machines and dryers) to build Sudsy and get the van working. On day three, a friend named Jordan used the service and taught Nic and Lucas that while clean clothes were important, it was the conversation and connection that mattered more.

WHAT MADE YOU SIGN UP FOR THE CHALLENGE?

In Australia, 1 in 200 people are experiencing homelessness. I want to support Orange Sky and the friends who rely on the service by wearing the same set of clothes for three days and choosing conversations with people in my community.

WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?
